LES CHALETS DES AIRELLES

Ultra luxury private chalets

This season will mark a new era for Les Airelles with the completion of two exceptional private chalets which have been created in response to the current trend for increased privacy. They will be located just steps from the hotel's main building, and all connected via discreet secret underground passageways. In keeping with the main hotel building, the new chalets have been designed by Christophe Tollemer and built in a traditional Savoyard style with authentic wood and stone exteriors, each boasting panoramic views of the snow-covered summit of the Saulire. Inside, guests can expect a revitalised take on Les Airelles' trademark spoiling warm and intimate atmosphere with crackling fires, cherrywood furnishings and rich interior fabrics, in cashmere and wool from Loro Piana Interiors.

The two highly-appointed chalets will be individually designed and configured, varying in size from 1,500sqm to 1,200sqm, accommodating between 12 to 15 guests.

Key facilities will include a large living area with fireplace and TV, elegant dining room, cinema room, games room with bar and pool table, a fully equipped children's playroom, a dedicated wellness area with indoor swimming pool, gym, sauna, relaxation area, hammam, Iyashi Dome and treatment room, as well as their own fully-equipped Bernard Orcel ski room and accompanying Ski Valet, private chef and sommelier and a dedicated chalet manager.

Chalet guests will also enjoy full access to the hotel facilities including seven restaurants (four onsite, three offsite); colourful Children's Kingdom; spoiling La Mer spa; exciting programme of Alpine experiences as well as access to Les Airelles' fleet of chauffeured Rolls Royce Cullinan.





L'APPARTEMENT

Renovation of the prestigious private penthouse

Guests can look forward to a new-look Penthouse Apartment this season from Airelles' Interior Designer of choice, Christophe Tollemer. Located on Les Airelles' top fourth floor, the generous four-bedroom Penthouse Apartment suite with views across Courchevel 1850's picturesque Jardin Alpin district and the three valley's snow-capped mountains will have a new feel this winter. Tollemer has chosen to combine the signature vivid shades of red, yellow and green combined with neutral earthy tones to create a feeling of warmth and cosiness which compliment the traditional Savoyard design. Outside, the spacious 150m² terrace has been completely renovated with a new Norwegian-style hot tub, perfect for that après ski relaxation.

The Penthouse apartment offers the superlative ski experience boasting four bedrooms each with its own private balcony, dressingroom, and ensuite bathroom complete with a hamman, walk-in shower and bath. Other stand-out features include a private spa, screening room, a dedicated playroom for children and a 10 person dining table where feasts en famille can be enjoyed.

Exclusive amenities for Penthouse apartment guests include a private butler, a Rolls Royce Cullinan and driver, helicopter airport transfers, a private fitness instructor upon request, and a personalised Balenciaga handbag.



NEW LOOK OUTDOOR ICE RINK

Guests will be able to practise their best versions of the Bolero on the new-look 30 metres long Airelles ice rink which has been significantly extended along with a new state-of-the-art sound and lighting system. Illuminated reindeer will occupy the centre of the rink with a dedicated area for little ones to skate safely at their own pace. Of course no alpine skating session is complete without the customary hot chocolate which will be served from a cosy wooden chalet in front of the rink along with other decadent sweet treats such as waffles and crepes.

NEW SLOPESIDE RESTAURANT

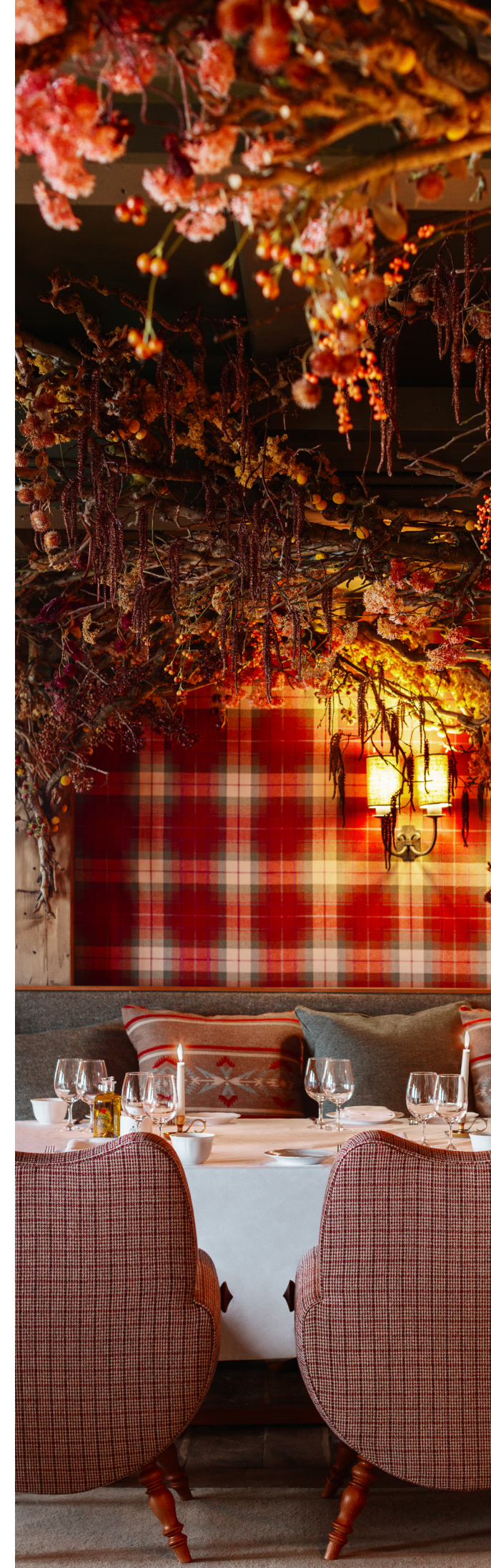

The boutique also extends the Airelles experience beyond Val d’Isère thanks to a selection of items sourced from other Airelles properties including Courchevel, Gordes, Versailles and Saint-Tropez.

AIRELLES COURCHEVEL, LES AIRELLES

Les Airlles in Courchevel is Airlles’ flagship property and inspiration behind the collection’s name. This historic Palace and magnificent hotel is nestled at the heart of the superlative Savoyard resort town of Courchevel, and is the resort’s most historic luxury hotel. Built in the prestigious Jardin Alpin domain and on the edge of the 1850 Courchevel ski slopes, lavishly decorated and appointed, yet warm and relaxing the Palace greatly resembles a 19th century Austro-Hungarian castle and every detail is a harmonious blend of intimacy and authenticity.

Les Airlles is home to four onsite restaurants; La Tables des Airlles serving legendary breakfast and lunchtime buffets and elegantly themed evening dinners; Carrara, the hotel’s fine-dining Italian restaurant; Le Coin Savoyard serving regional cuisine and La Cave des Grands Crus, a private-dining experience for up to 16 diners within a wine cellar of one of the new chalets. Les Airlles’ bar and fumoir provides a luxurious cosy evening atmosphere. Chalet de Pierres, La Folie Douce (Méribel) and Nama at Aman Le Mélezin are Les Airlles’ mountainside restaurants on the slopes of Courchevel 1850.

Les Airlles is home to a La Mer Spa with unique cryotherapy treatments. Airlles Winter Camp is home to an ice rink, heated treehouse, carousel, cinema room and indoor arcade. Five-star luxury continues at Les Airlles’ dedicated Bernard Orcel Ski Room.

Rates at Airlles Courchevel, Les Airlles start from €1,700 for a Classic Room on a half-board basis, and including a unique alpine experience.

Rates at the hotel’s chalets start from €140,000 for seven nights on a full-board basis.

AIRELLES VAL D’ISÈRE

Airlles Val d’Isère is superbly situated at the Place de Neige, in the very centre of the village, with ski-in ski-out access. Positioned directly at the base of the slopes, the spacious hotel is surrounded by nature with panoramic mountain range views.

The landmark building has been reborn with 41 keys, including 9 suites and 5 private penthouses, complete with their own dedicated butler. Airlles Val d’Isère is home to three restaurants including LOULOU with a sun-filled wrap-around 800m² terrace and the recently refurbished La Grande Ourse. Airlles Val d’Isère also hosts a serene Guerlain spa, the largest in the ski resort. Perfect for families, the hotel has created the Airlles Winter Camp, entirely designed with children in mind.

Rates at Airlles Val d’Isère start from €1’200 for a Premier room on a half-board basis, and including a unique alpine experience.
